

Public Hearing
Motor Freight Terminal Conditional Use Hearing #16
May 20, 2008

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a continued public hearing on May 20, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Richard A. Bucher called the hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Robert Shearer, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, and Recording Secretary Dana A. Billet.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag opened the meeting.

Chairman Bucher ask if there were any administrative items to be discussed. The Board had none. Chairman Bucher ask if Solicitor Allshouse had any. Solicitor Allshouse stated he did. Solicitor Allshouse stated that they had scheduled the next hearing for June 10th. Solicitor Allshouse stated he had been informed that there is a Zoning Hearing Board meeting scheduled on that same date. Solicitor Allshouse noted that they would need to change the next hearing date. After a brief discussion it was decided that the meeting originally scheduled for June 10th would be moved to June 11th at 6:30pm. Solicitor Allshouse also reminded council that they will meet informally at 6:00pm on June 11th to discuss the exhibits.

Stephen Mathey, who testified at the previous hearing regarding the noise levels was called to the stand to continue his testimony. Mr. Lucas resumed his questioning of Mr. Mathey. After Mr. Lucas questioned Mr. Mathey the Board of Supervisors, Mr. Moore and Mr. Wolf were then given the opportunity to question Mr. Mathey. Mr. Moore had no questions.

Doug Plank, the Director of Transportation Services for ELA was then called to the stand for testimony. Mr. Plank has worked for PennDOT in the area of Traffic Design and for the City of Lancaster as a Traffic Engineer. Mr. Plank was testifying in regards to the Traffic Studies which were completed by Grove Miller and the letters from Trans Associates in response to the Grove Miller Traffic Study.

Mr. Plank's testimony will resume at the June 11th hearing.
