

**Public Hearing
Ordinance 2008-05
October 2, 2008**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2008-05 on October 2, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Vice Chairman Robert H. Shearer called the public hearing to order at 6:50 p.m. Board members present were Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman. Chairman Richard A. Bucher was not in attendance. Visitors: See October 2, 2008 attendance sheet.

Solicitor Allshouse noted the proposed ordinance was an ordinance of North Middleton Township amending the North Middleton Township Code Chapter 146 peddling and soliciting in its entirety. The purpose of the ordinance is to provide for the proper regulation of peddling and solicitation and other transient retail businesses within North Middleton Township to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the public together in compliance with all federal, state and local laws. The ordinance was advertised in The Carlisle Sentinel the week of September 15, 2008 and September 27, 2008. A copy of the public notice was provided to the Cumberland County Law library, The Sentinel, and Carlisle Area School District. A copy was made available at the Township Municipal Building for public review.

Supervisor Kelso questioned Section 146-3 in which the fees are discussed. Solicitor Allshouse noted the fees would be set from time to time by resolution by the Board of Supervisors in the following categories.
