

**Public Hearing  
Ordinance 2008-06  
October 2, 2008**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2008-06 on October 2, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Vice Chairman Robert H. Shearer called the public hearing to order at 6:45 p.m. Board members present were Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman. Chairman Richard A. Bucher was not in attendance.

Solicitor Allshouse noted the proposed ordinance was an ordinance amending the code of the Township of North Middleton with respect to intergovernmental cooperation for special fire police mutual aid and emergency assistance. The purpose of the ordinance was to provide for intergovernmental cooperation and coordination of North Middleton Township Fire Police to provide for mutual aid and emergency assistance to the surrounding county and municipalities. The ordinance was advertised in The Carlisle Sentinel the weeks of September 15, 2008 and September 27, 2008. A copy of the public notice was provided to the Cumberland County Law library, The Carlisle Sentinel, and Carlisle Area School District. A copy was made available at the Township Municipal Building for public review.

**Public Comment**

Rick Hoover of 1190 Newville Road asked if the ordinance gave the county authority over the special fire police. Solicitor Allshouse noted the ordinance allows the county to have some control over where the special fire police from all the municipalities are distributed.

**Supervisors Comments**

No comments were offered.

Supervisor Kelso moved to approve Ordinance 2008-06, and Supervisor Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried.
