

**Public Hearing
Motor Freight Terminal Conditional Use Hearing #24
October 20, 2008**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a continued public hearing on October 20, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Richard A. Bucher called the hearing to order at 6:30pm. Board members present Vice Chairman Robert Shearer, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, and Recording Secretary Dana A. Billet

The Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag opened the meeting.

Supervisor Bucher stated there was an executive session regarding potential litigation. Supervisor Kelso made a motion to accept Dr. Carey's report as read. Supervisor Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4 – 1. Supervisor Reisinger stated he had some concerns regarding the report.

Supervisor Bucher ask if there were any additional administrative issues. The Board had none.

Discussion was held between Solicitor Allshouse, Mr. Lucas and Mr. Wolf regarding the testimony of Dr. Carey. After the discussion was held it was decided to go ahead with Dr. Carey's testimony.

Dr. Philip Carey was sworn in to give testimony. Dr. Carey stated he has attended six of the hearings regarding the proposed plan.

Mr. Wolf provided copies of a report that Dr. Carey wrote on September 8, 2008.

Dr. Carey provided testimony in regards to the affects of diesel particulates on lungs and other health issues that could arise.

Dr. Carey demonstrated a nebulizer and a meter dose inhaler which provide medication to go deep inside the lungs.

Dr. Carey stated he has examined 12 individuals over the age of 65 years that live within the vicinity of the proposed plan. Dr. Carey stated he has seen pre-existing conditions such as, asthma, cardiac arrhythmia, lung cancer, COPD, coronary artery disease, myocardial infractions, congestive heart failure and stroke.

The cross examination of Dr. Carey will continue at the November 12, 2008 hearing. Mr. Wolf stated that Dr. Carey may not be available that date. Mr. Wolf will let everyone know by October 31 whether or not he will be available.

Solicitor Allshouse stated additional hearing dates are scheduled for November 12 and December 10, 2008.

Supervisor Bucher moved to continue the public hearing to November 12, 2008 at 6:30pm. Supervisor Kelso seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
