

**Public Hearing  
Ordinance 2008-08  
November 6, 2008**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2008-08 on November 6, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Richard A. Bucher called the public hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Robert H. Shearer, Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman.

Solicitor Allshouse noted the proposed ordinance was an ordinance of North Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania amending the North Middleton Township Code Chapter 170-3, solid waste and recycling definition of leaf waste and solid waste. Solicitor Allshouse noted the Township was contacted by the state in order to retain the recycling funds. The state required the Township to amend the definition of leaf waste and solid waste in order to comply with the state definitions and in order to retain the solid waste recycling funding.

The ordinance and public notice of the ordinance was advertised in The Sentinel the weeks of October 13, 2008 and October 20, 2008. A copy of the notice was deposited with the Cumberland County Law Library on October 7, 2008 by Codes Enforcement Officer Paul Fegley of which he provided a signed letter.
