

**Public Hearing
Ordinance 2008-10
Intergovernmental Agreement with Upper Frankford Township
November 6, 2008**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2008-10 on November 6, 2008 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Richard A. Bucher called the public hearing to order at 6:40 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Robert H. Shearer, Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert Reisinger, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman.

Solicitor Allshouse noted the proposed ordinance was an ordinance authorizing the Township of North Middleton to enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement for the establishment and operation of a joint UCC Board of Appeals under 35 P.S §7210-501(c).

The ordinance and public notice of the ordinance was advertised in The Sentinel the weeks of October 13, 2008 and October 20, 2008 as required by the MPC. A copy of the notice was deposited with the Cumberland County Law Library on October 7, 2008 by Codes Enforcement Officer Paul Fegley of which he provided a signed letter.

Supervisor Kelso verified information was exchanged with Upper Frankford on the approximate cost for a public hearing. Ms. Ealer noted the amount was an estimate since NMT has never had a hearing under the UCC Board of Appeals. Solicitor Allshouse noted the procedure was very similar to a Zoning Hearing Board hearing. Then, Supervisor Bucher moved to approve Ordinance 2008-10, and Supervisor Shearer seconded the motion. The motion carried.
