

**Public Hearing**  
**Ordinance 2007-01-Block Rezone Application Newville Road**  
**January 5, 2009**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a continued public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2007-01 on January 5, 2009 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Robert Reisinger called the public hearing to order at 6:32 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Harry Kelso, Supervisor Dennis Hurley, Supervisor Robert H. Shearer, Supervisor Richard A. Bucher, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer, and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman.

Solicitor Allshouse stated this was the time and place set for the Block Rezoning Application on Newville Road to change the zoning from I-2 to R-2. He referenced a letter dated December 16, 2008 from the applicant's attorney Nathan C. Wolf requesting a general extension of time for the opening of the block rezone hearing. The applicants' are seeking to have a completion of the Third Pine Floor conditional use application prior to this hearing. Mr. Wolf requested the application be postponed until the first action meeting in April 2009.

Supervisor Kelso moved to grant the extension request from Nathan C. Wolf to continue the public hearing on the Block Rezone Application on Newville Road to April 2, 2009. Supervisor Shearer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The hearing was closed at 6:34 p.m.
