

**Public Hearing**  
**Ordinance 2008-03#5 Proposed Zoning Map Amendment**  
**Block Rezone Continuance**  
**March 5, 2009**

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2008-03#5 on March 5, 2009 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Robert Reisinger called the public hearing to order at 7:05 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert H. Shearer, Supervisor James E. Hare, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah A. Ealer, and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman. Supervisor Richard A. Bucher was not in attendance.

Visitors: No visitors were in attendance for the hearing.

Solicitor Allshouse noted the issue was continued several times since the original date of the application. The Township received written notice dated March 4, 2009 from John M. Bower of 35 Calvary Road that he will be no longer be pursuing the Block Rezone along Rt. 11 and would not be in attendance for the hearing. He thanked the board for their time and effort as noted in his correspondence. Solicitor Allshouse entered Mr. Bower's letter as a Township exhibit in consecutive order to the last and requested a copy be placed with the minutes from the regular meeting. He added the board had no further action to take and the application would be considered withdrawn.
