

Public Hearing
Ordinance 2007-01 Block Rezone Application Newville Road
November 5, 2009

The North Middleton Township Supervisors held a continued public hearing concerning proposed Ordinance 2007-01 on November 5, 2009 at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. Chairman Robert Reisinger called the public hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Harry Kelso, Supervisor Robert H. Shearer, Supervisor Richard A. Bucher, Supervisor James E. Hare, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Manager Deborah Ealer, and Recording Secretary Lori A. Coleman.

Solicitor Allshouse stated this was the time and place set for the Block Rezone Application on Newville Road to change the zoning from I-2 to N-C. The meeting was readvertised for this evening based upon a change in the application. The block rezone application added and removed certain properties, and changed the classification of the zoning sought. Solicitor Allshouse noted receipt of a letter dated November 3, 2009 from Nathan C. Wolf requesting a continuation and general extension for opening the hearing on the block rezone petition that was originally filed on September 18, 2007. Solicitor Allshouse noted he was requesting a continuance of the hearing to the first regular meeting on March 5, 2010.

Supervisor Kelso moved to grant the extension request from Nathan C. Wolf to continue the public hearing on the Block Rezone Application on Newville Road to March 5, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. Supervisor Shearer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The hearing was closed at 7:05 p.m.
