

**NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 2008 – 02**

**AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING, CHANGING AND
MODIFYING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH
MIDDLETON, 2001, CHAPTER 164 SEWERS AND
WATER, SECTION 164-34.A. AND B. SEWER RENTALS
AND CHARGES, AND SECTION 164-97. WATER RATES,
RENTS AND CHARGES**

The Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1: AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 164. SEWERS AND WATER.
SECTION 164 – 34.A. AND B. SEWER RENTALS AND CHARGES

The Code of the Township of North Middleton, 2001, Chapter 164. Sewers and Water, Section 164-34.A. and B. Sewer Rentals and Charges, shall be amended, changed and modified as follows:

A. RESIDENTIAL RATES.

i. Residential Metered Sewage Rates Commencing March 7, 2008:

First 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$56.55
All use over 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$5.01/1000 gallons
Minimum Metered Charge per bi-monthly period per residential dwelling unit	\$56.55
Flat sewage rate per bi-monthly period per residential dwelling unit	\$75.71

B. NON-RESIDENTIAL RATES.

i. Non-Residential Metered Sewage Rates commencing March 7, 2008:

First 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$64.69
All use over 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$5.01/1000 gallons
Flat sewage rate per bi-monthly period per non-residential unit – per equivalent dwelling unit	\$97.03

Section 2: AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 164. SEWERS AND WATER.
SECTION 164 – 97. WATER RATES, RENTS AND CHARGES.

The Code of the Township of North Middleton, 2001, Chapter 164. Sewers and Water, Section 164 – 97. Water rates, rent and charges, shall be amended, changed and modified as follows:

Water rates, rent and charges are imposed upon and shall be collected from all water customers of each improved property, whether such use or benefit resulting there from or such connection shall be direct or indirect. Such rates, rents and charges shall be at a rate based upon a gallon of water per bi-monthly billing cycle measured through the meter in accordance with the following rate schedule:

A. RESIDENTIAL RATES.

i. Residential Metered Water Rates Commencing March 7, 2008:

First 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$25.75
All use over 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$6.18/1000 gallons
Minimum Metered Charge per bi-monthly period per residential dwelling unit	\$25.75

B. NON-RESIDENTIAL RATES.

i. Non-Residential Metered Water Rates Commencing March 7, 2008

First 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$29.46
All use over 6,000 gallons per bi-monthly use	\$6.18/1000 gallons
Minimum charge per bi-monthly period	\$29.46

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE OF REVISED RATES AND CHARGES.

The above revised rates and charges shall be effective commencing March 7, 2008.

Section 4. RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER ORDINANCES.

All other Ordinances, parts of Ordinances or part of Resolutions inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and the same expressly are repealed, except to the extent required for enforcement of rates or charges as imposed hereby.

Section 5. CONTINUATION.

The provisions of this Ordinance, so far as they are the same as those of Ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such Ordinances and not as new enactments. Provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any ordinance repealed by this Ordinance.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.


Section 7. SEVERABILITY.

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance or other Ordinances affected by this Ordinance, it being the intent of North Middleton Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.






